

CHARLES AND LUCILE MCCOY KRUEGER SCHOLARSHIP TC-ADN

The Charles and Lucile McCoy Krueger Scholarship assists Temple College nursing students in the freshman and sophomore years of an associate degree program in nursing. All tuition, fees and texts are paid. A monthly stipend may be available for additional expenses of training.

Upon graduation from the associate degree program in nursing, a commitment of up to two years full-time employment at Scott & White as a registered nurse is requested, depending on the amount of funding given.

GUIDELINES

1. Applicants must complete and return scholarship application postmarked by April 15.
2. Applicant must be United States citizens.
3. Applicants who are Scott & White employees must have exhibited an overall satisfactory performance rating on their most recent Scott & White performance evaluations.
4. Applicant must be accepted as a nursing student at Temple College, Temple, Texas.
5. Final selection is based on recipient meeting the criteria and interviews with the Nursing Education Assistance Committee.
6. Each recipient will be expected to sign a contract of agreement.
7. Recipient is expected to be a full-time student.
8. Any recipient who terminates course work, fails any course or achieves less than a C in any nursing course will lose the scholarship and return the tuition, fees, cost of the required texts and stipend, in total or paid out with a 5% interest accrual.
9. Recipient is asked to be employed as a registered nurse full-time for one year for every year funded. Employment as Scott & White is required to fulfill the agreement.
10. At the end of each semester, recipient will send a copy of his or her semester grades to the Nursing Education Assistance Coordinator.
