

CHARLES & LUCILE MCCOY KRUEGER SCHOLARSHIP - UNIVERSITY OF MARY HARDIN BAYLOR

The Charles and Lucile McCoy Kruger Scholarship assists the UMHB nursing student in the junior and/or senior years of the bachelor of science in nursing program. All tuition, fees and texts are paid, as available. A monthly stipend may be available for additional expenses of training.

Upon graduation from the bachelor of science in nursing program, a commitment of 12 months of full-time employment is requested for each year assistance is received. Employment at Scott & White as a registered nurse is requested.

GUIDELINES

1. Applicants must complete and return scholarship application postmarked by April 15.
2. Applicants must be United States citizens.
3. Applicants who are Scott & White employees must have exhibited an overall satisfactory performance rating on their most recent Scott & White performance evaluations.
4. Applicants must be accepted as a nursing student at the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor.
5. Final selection is based on recipient meeting the criteria and interviews with the Nursing Education Assistance Committee.
6. Each recipient will be expected to sign an agreement.
7. Recipient is expected to be a full-time student.
8. Any recipient who terminates course work, fails any course or achieves less than a C in any nursing course will lose the scholarship and return the tuition, fees, costs of required texts and stipend, in total or paid out with 5% interest.
9. Recipient is asked to be employed at Scott & White as a registered nurse full-time one year for each scholarship year following graduation providing inpatient care.
10. At the end of each semester, recipient will send a copy of his or her semester grades to the Nursing Education Assistance Coordinator.
