Participation in this study will consist of normal pre and post-operative visits expected for undergoing pelvic floor dysfunction contact surgery. At the end of six months a post-operative visit will also occur either in person or by telephone.

- 1) At your preoperative appointment, you will be:
    - a) Examined by a physician.
    - b) Asked to fill out a quality of life questionnaire and goals you hope to achieve from the proposed pelvic floor dysfunction surgery.
    - c) You will then be asked to rank your goals
  - 2) At the six- week and six- month post-operative appointments, you will be:
    - a. Examined by the physician
    - b. Asked to fill out a quality of life questionnaire

- c. Asked to fill out an assessment of your preoperative goals
  - d. Asked to rate your satisfaction with the surgery.
- 3) If you are not seen at the 6- month visit, a phone call will be made to re-evaluate the achievement of your preoperative goals.
