Scott & White Community Cycling Club Code of Conduct

No code of conduct can be comprehensive enough to anticipate and cover every situation that may arise. If it could, it would be too onerous to be familiar with and in compliance with. This code is not intended to be comprehensive; rather, it should function as a guideline, with common sense and the principle of "what would a reasonable person do in a similar situation" being the application of these guidelines.

In addition to the above mentioned principle, there are specific items in the code that every member is accountable to know and behave in accordance with:

1. All members must be aware that they are ambassadors for the Scott & White brand name when wearing S&WCCC attire or participating in S&WCCC events. Therefore, common courtesy and good manners are called for. Foul language and rude behavior is not permitted and should be avoided.
2. All rules of the road and standards of group cycling behavior should be observed.
3. All riders must always wear a helmet.
4. No riding while under the influence of any substance.
5. Avoid confrontations with motorists; if one occurs, avoid an argument. If need be, take a license plate number and call 911 on your cell phone.
6. We are a club involved with the community. Keep that in mind while riding, encountering other riders, motorists, pedestrians, etc. Endeavor to present yourself and the S&WCCC club in a positive light.

Violation of the Code of Conduct will result in due process by the cycling club and may possibly result in removal from the SWCCC. In the event that a cyclist's membership is revoked, he or she must surrender all S&W apparel and accessories including the jersey, shorts, bibs, and other accessories bearing the S&W logo and name; and will be reimbursed at a depreciated amount. By signing below, you are indicating your commitment to abide by the code of conduct and in the event of a violation, you agree to surrender all SWCCC apparel back to the club.
